<p>PSED (Personal, Social, Emotional Development)</p> <p>Settling into our new classrooms. Turn taking and sharing during play. Learning daily routines, rules and expectations. Developing relationships with their peers and adults.</p>	<p>Communication & Language</p> <p>Settling and making friends. Developing communication skills during our 'All about me' topic. Discussing and developing language around classroom routines, including 'choosing time', 'reset time' and 'Maths'.</p>	<p>Physical Development</p> <p>Using the toilet independently. Managing own clothing and shoes. Developing fine motor skills e.g. threading, cutting and weaving. Pencil grip - establishing correct pencil grip for writing. Developing gross motor skills e.g. running, jumping and climbing.</p>
<p>Literacy</p> <p>Begin phase 2 phonics (Set 1: s, a, t, p; Set 2: i, n, m, d; Set 3: g, o, c, k; Set 4: ck, e, u, r; Set 5: h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss). Learning new vocabulary through stories and songs. Acting out familiar stories. Listen to traditional tales including Goldilocks and The Three Bears, Little Red Riding Hood and Jack and the Beanstalk. Name writing and letter formation. Segmenting and blending CVC words - sat, pin, pat, cat. Reading our Top 10 texts. Pencil grip - establishing correct pencil grip for writing.</p>		<p>Maths</p> <p>Learning class routines and timetable. Matching and sorting items in different e.g size, colour, type. Exploring and making repeating pattern, using different objects. Comparing amounts, using words 'more' and 'less'. Using and understanding positional language, e.g under, on top, beside.</p>
<p>Understanding the World</p> <p>Talk about different members of our family and how our families have changed over time. Developing communication and language skills by talking about our favorite toys during the carpet session. Noticing seasonal changes by exploring autumn using different senses.
